## FLIGHT ADVISORY GPS Interference Testing PAXR GPS 12-07 July 03, 2012 – August 01, 2012 Patuxent River, MD


GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 381542N/0762602W or the PXT VOR 225.3 degree radial at 2.2NM.
- B. Dates and times:

03-07 July 12	1300-2200Z
10-14 July 12	1300-2200Z
17-21 July 12	1300-2200Z
24-28 July 12	1300-2200Z
31 July 12	1300-2200Z
01 August 12	1300-2200Z

- C. Duration: Each event may last the entire time during the requested periods.
- D. During testing, the GPS signal may be unreliable or unavailable within a 15NMR and centered at 381542N/0762602W or the location also known as the PXT VOR 225.3 degree radial at 2.2 NM from 50 FT AGL to FL400 and above.
- E. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
