## FLIGHT ADVISORY GPS INTERFERENCE TESTING

## JFAK (JOINT FORCE ALASKA) 17-01

## 1 – 12 May, 2017 Fairbanks, Alaska

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 645447N1464448W or the FAI VOR 059 degree radial at 33NM.
- B. Dates and times:

1-5 MAY 17	1800-2000Z	0100-0300Z
8-12 MAY 17	1800-2000Z	0100-0300Z

- C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.
- D. NOTAM INFO: NAV (JFAK GPS 17-01) GPS (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 532NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 645447N1464448W (FAI 059033) FL400-UNL, 474NM RADIUS AT FL250
  401NM RADIUS AT FL250
  401NM RADIUS AT 10000FT 386NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL 345NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL
- E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
