TFR Avoidance

How to avoid a fighter escort! Includes a brief summary of NORAD Operations and fool proof methods to ensure pilots avoid TFRs and a NORAD Fighter Intercepts.

Ever wonder what it takes to get a fighter escort? Or, better yet, . . . what should you do if you see an F-16 off your wing? NORAD will let us know how to avoid an escort and, just as important, what is going in the cockpit of that F-16 off your wing and what you need to do next.

The central pillar of our program is direct interaction with GA and corporate pilots at fly-ins, tradeshow, and conferences to raise pilot awareness of TFRs and teach civilian pilots the skills and procedures to avoid them. We train pilots on proper preflight planning, TFR avoidance and intercept procedures.
