This briefing will show the process of how accidents are tracked and followed on a world-wide basis and we use case studies to review the latest trends and lessons learned. The Aviation Industry not only supports FAA/NTSB-led Investigations as a party member, it also conducts independent, parallel investigations to provide continuous operational safety. Jointly, with the FAA, industry monitors and tracks every aviation accident or incident that occurs domestically, or involves a US registered aircraft abroad. Daily, industry responds to the FAA preliminary accident data in the Preliminary Accident/Incident Database, which is shared with the Aviation Safety Information Analysis and Sharing (ASIAS) program
