TALPA The New Runway Condition Reporting System

Through recent Safety Seminars and Discussions with local industry stakeholders, the FAA Safety Team has found that many stakeholders are not yet familiar or have even heard that significant changes in airport field condition reporting standards have gone into effect as of October 1, 2016.

The "New Field Condition" (FICON) NOTAMs and Reporting using the "Runway Condition Assessment Matrix" (RCAM) codes are in effect and currently being used at the Fairbanks International Airport. These significant changes in Takeoff and Landing Performance Assessment (TALPA) practices and reporting affect all aviation stakeholders: pilots and aircraft operators, airports, as well as air traffic controllers.
