# **AASF Fall Safety Seminar**

Dr. Bill Rhodes, from Aerworthy Consulting will walk the audience through a flight simulator session and talk to the audience about professionalism in aviation. Professor Dale Wilson, from Central Washington University will provide tips on avoiding inadvertent flight from visual flight rules (VFR) into instrument meteorological conditions (IMC) and provide advice to help keep pilots safe while flying at night.
