Directions: The Coast International Inn is at the intersection of West International Airport Road and Jewel Lake Road, just East of the Lake Spenard complex at the Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport. At the intersection traffic signal, turn north onto Jewel Lake Road for a very short distance and turn left at the first street onto Aviation Avenue (just past the Alaska Park facility). There is a large, DC-6 aircraft just adjacent to the parking area at the main hotel entrance on the south side of the hotel and parking is free at the hotel (See attached map at this link). The event is in the McKinley East Room inside the main entrance.
