A discussion on the FAA's Sport Pilot and Light Sport Aircraft regulations.

Directions: The seminar will be located in the McDonnell Douglas-Green Aviation Technical Center.
FROM THE WEST: Take US 50 E approximately 1.5 miles past the city limit of Linn. On your left is the Osage County Community Center. Just past the OCCC is the entrance to campus. FROM THE EAST: From I-44 at Union take US 50 W about 40 miles. At Potts you will pass HWY 89 North. The campus is about 2 miles west of this intersection. The campus is on your right. FROM THE NORTH: Take HWY 63 South to Jefferson City. Take US 50 E out of Jeff-City and follow the above directions "FROM THE WEST." FROM THE SOUTH: Take HWY 63 N towards Jeff-City. North of Westphalia turn right onto US 50 E. Follow the above directions "FROM THE WEST."
