Directions: From Downtown St. Louis: Cross the Poplar Street Bridge to the IL Rt. 3 South Exit. Turn Left onto Queeney Avenue (at stop light). Turn Right onto Falling Springs Rd (at stop sign). Turn Left onto Curtis Steinberg Drive. Turn Right onto Vector Drive (at stop sign). Continue on Vector around the west side of the airport. Turn Left onto Airflight Drive. Ideal Aviation is Hangar # 3, the white hangar with the Shell Aviation signs. Public Parking is behind the two big brick hangars, which are Hangar #1 and #2

From Interstate 255: Exit 15 onto Mousette Lane / Sauget Industrial Parkway.

From 255 North, you will Turn Left. From 255 South, you will Turn Right.

Continue on Sauget Industrial Parkway?(Note that Sauget Industrial Parkway becomes Vector Drive where it crosses Curtis Steinberg Drive). Continue on Vector around the west side of the airport. Turn Left onto Airflight Drive, Ideal Aviation is Hangar # 3, the white hangar with the Shell Aviation signs. Public Parking is behind the two big brick hangars, which are Hangar #1 and #2
