Breakfast and Deli Lunch Provided**

Registration: 7:30 - 8:00 am. This is an all day event. This year, we add afternoon break-outs for pilots, mechanics and management. Also, there will be static helicopter displays and vendors booths. PRE-register at faasafety.gov number (CE0380721).

Directions: DRIVING DIRECTIONS: The FAA SAFETY CENTER/Orlando Field Office is located on Lakeland Linder airport. From Interstate 4, take County Line Road (Exit 25) south approximately 3.6 miles to Medulla RD / Old Medulla Rd. Turn left on Medulla Rd/Old Medulla Road, and proceed approximately 1.6 miles to the Central Florida Aerospace Academy Campus entrance. Proceed straight ahead on Doolittle Road and turn left onto Sun 'n Fun Road just before the closed airport gate. Continue on SUN 'n FUN road and make a left on Laird Road, the FAA Aviation Safety Center is on your right, park on the West side of the building – not on the grass. From Highway 60, take County Line Road north approximately 3.8 miles to Medulla RD / Old Medulla Rd. Turn right on Medulla Rd/Old Medulla Road, and proceed approximately 1.6 miles to the Central Florida Aerospace Academy Campus entrance. Then follow the directions above. From Lakeland take Pipkin Road west to Medulla Road, turn right and proceed about ½ mile to the Central Florida Aerospace Academy Campus entrance on the right.. Then follow the directions above.

FLYING IN: The Safety Center/Orlando Field Office is located at Lakeland Linder International Airport (KLAL). They will be setting up for Sun 'n Fun, so please contact the FBO to make arrangements on how they want to handle getting to the safety center
