

The Schiff Show - Climbing Blind- the Fatal Failure to Maintain Positive Rate

On an early morning flight, a Cirrus SR22 departed the airport into total darkness. The pilot failed to establish and maintain a positive climb rate, resulting in a shallow descent into terrain — claiming two lives, including the pilot's young daughter.
