

High-Tech - High Risk? When Avionics Bite Back

In this episode of THE SCHIFF SHOW, Captains Brian Schiff and Captain Mike Jesch have a practical discussion about the equipment that can make flying safer—but only when pilots truly understand how to use it.

We'll examine a recent fatal accident involving a YouTube creator whose escalating pitch-control difficulties and confusion about autopilot and trim operation led to pilot-induced oscillations and a loss of control. The NTSB found no evidence of a mechanical problem that would have prevented normal operation.
