# Aviation Weather - Turbulence

Part 2 of a 4-part Aviation Weather Seminar series focuses on turbulence and the hazards of flying in it. Participants will be given a 30 minute presentation focused on identifying the potential for turbulence and a tutorial of the weather products available to assist in their pre-flight weather brief. Following the presentation, participants will be given a tour of the operations area at the Aviation Weather Center and a chance to speak with our aviation weather forecasters.
