Aviation Weather - Flight Planning and understanding TAFs

Part 3 of the Aviation Weather Seminar: this presentation gives a basic overview of the National Weather Service, flight hazard planning considerations, and refresher instruction on terminal aerodrome forecasts. Flight weather hazard topics include ceilings, visibility, precipitation, thunderstorms, turbulence, and icing. Additionally, various web resources are introduced and strategies are discussed in order to maximize weather threat awareness before departure. Following the presentation, participants will be given a tour of the operations area at the Aviation Weather Center and a chance to speak with our aviation weather forecasters.
