

How to Prevent and How to Handle Loss of Control in Flight

Most pilots know the seriousness of losing control of their aircraft. It is the number one cause of fatal accidents in general aviation. Understanding the mechanics of the stall and spin recovery does not always prevent the stall spin from occurring. During this seminar the speaker will explore contributing factors that result in loss of control, and how a pilot can recognize and take action to prevent this from happening.

From Cooperstown, head south on Pioneer Street towards Main Street, take County Road 11 and NY-205-S to Airport Road in Laurens, continue on Airport Road, drive to Wallace Road, turn left onto Airport Road, then direct to Oneonta Municipal Airport.

From I-88 in Oneonta, take Route 205 North to Airport Road, then drive one mile to the airport entrance on your left, the airport has clearly marked airport signs.
