

WINGS Made Easy for Flight Instructors and FAASafety Team Representatives – Giving Credit for Activities




These instructions are intended to show:

- How a Flight Instructor, FAASafety Team Representative for FAASafety Program Manager (FPM) gives credit for a WINGS activity.


Prerequisites:

- WINGS Participant has created a **FAASafety.gov** website account.
- WINGS Participant has created his/her **WINGS Profile**.
- WINGS Participant has completed the activity for which he/she is requesting credit.
- Flight Instructor has created a **FAASafety.gov** account.




Note: if a CFI does not have a **FAASafety.gov** account, a WINGS Participant will have to contact a FAASafety Team Representative or Program Manager for credit. The WINGS Participant will be expected to show proof on completion of the activity.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. The email will indicate who is requesting credit, what the activity is and the date completed.

<p>15. Review the WINGS - Credit Validation introductory comments.</p> <p>16. Review the Accredited Activity Credits to Approve.</p>	<p>WINGS - Credit Validation</p> <p>Welcome to the WINGS - Pilot Proficiency Program – Credit Validation page. This is where you can validate any WINGS - Pilot Proficiency Program activities that armen have requested of you. This is a simple process. It is important for you to realize that you are not necessarily saying that you flew or conducted the training with the requesting armen. You are saying that you have seen and can verify that this person provided you with logbook endorsements or other suitable evidence that they have completed the training as indicated.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Select from the list shown Make sure you have seen the armen demonstrate to the applicable standards all of the elements of the activity, which can be viewed by clicking on the title of the activity, or you have seen a record of completion such as a logbook endorsement that identifies this activity as having been completed. Validate the activity or Reject the activity <ol style="list-style-type: none"> You may choose to reject an activity if you have no knowledge of the person or the training or if the training requested is a course or activity other than what you can verify. (This could happen by the armen selecting the wrong activity or wrong person when requesting validation.) If you reject an activity the armen will be notified via email with any comments you place in the remarks box on the form. Review the WINGS – Credit Validation introductory material that appears on the page and is shown to the right.</p>	 <p>WINGS - Credit Validation</p> <p>By clicking on approve, below, you are certifying that you have given the training and verify that they have met or exceeded the completion standards for the course or activity listed or, you are certifying that you have seen a completion certificate or other training record, such as a logbook endorsement, that clearly identifies the course or activity listed and the airman's completion of all of its requirements. If the requester has entered any information incorrectly or if you can not validate their completion of the course or activity listed, you should reject the request at which time you will be given space to write a brief comment on why you rejected it. The airman will be notified by email and may resubmit the request with the correct information. 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<p>25. If you click the Reject radial dot, a comment window will open.</p> <p>26. Fill in the reason for the rejection. This will be included in the FAA's email back to the requestor.</p> <p>27. Click on Submit.</p>	
<p>28. Wait for the information to be recorded in the WINGS database. This may take up to a minute.</p> <p>29. You will see the message “This Credit has been rejected” at the bottom of the WINGS – Credit Validation introductory material.</p>	
<p>30. The email sent to the requestor after a rejection is illustrated to the right.</p>	
<p>You should be looking for this type of log book entry if a participant is asking you as either a CFI or FAASTeam Program Manager or Representative to give him/her credit for training done by someone else.</p> <p>This endorsement will be used for flight training.</p>
