

Where am I?

Although it's possible for a pilot to avoid towered airports, doing so impacts the flexibility and utility of flying. Two things distinguish a towered airport. The first is the presence of air traffic controllers (ATC), whose primary function is to coordinate traffic flow. The second is that a pilot must maintain two-way radio contact with the tower and obtain a clearance to enter the airspace, land, taxi, and take off.
