Any cross-country flight requires critical Aeronautical Decision Making (ADM) including a thorough review of intended route, airspace, weather, equipment, and pilot readiness. But flying cross-country in a glider introduces additional challenges including the greater likelihood of an off-field landing. Please join us at this seminar for a discussion of best practices in this area, including essential survival skills that might be required after an out landing and related medical issues such as first-aid and hypothermia. Our guest speakers will be Dave Cooke, an experienced power and glider pilot and CFI, and Dr. Bill Thar, an experienced glider pilot and retired physician.
