At this interesting seminar we will review the ABC's & DEG's of airspace and also discuss Automatic Dependent Surveillance Broadcast (ADS-B) and Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS/drones). A brief overview of controlled, uncontrolled, and special use airspace will be conducted, followed by a discussion of what's required to fly a UAS, where we should expect to see them, and what to do if we encounter a UAS in flight. Additionally, we will cover the impending ADS-B requirements as well as the benefits and limitations of this technology. We hope pilots of all types, including UAS, will join us to gain a better understanding of airspace and how these fascinating new technologies will affect the NAS..
