It's certainly a surprise because no one plans to lose control unless you are practicing aerobatic maneuvers that involve intentional out of control flight. Loss of Control - In Flight (LOC-IF) is evident in more general aviation fatal accidents than any other cause. So, if you ARE surprised by an LOC-IF what can you do? Better yet, what can you learn to prevent LOC-IF? And, what are the typical general aviation LOC-IF scenarios to precipitate LOC-IF? A review of stall aerodynamics and a visualization of wing airflow from a GoPro video will highlight the presentation.
