Instructors advance pilots through a regulated system of certificates and ratings, transitioning pilots to different aircraft and technologies and ensuring that pilots satisfy FAA, insurance, and flight school or company recurrence requirements. Though the reasons for increased attrition among students and other pilots are many, instructors often represent the first and last lines of defense to motivate pilots to continue in aviation.
