Directions: From 1-95 or B/W Parkway, go east on MD 32. From 1--97, go west on MD 32. Exit MD 32 at MD 198 West. Turn left at first stop light, Airport Road. Turn left at General Aviation Drive. The Old Firehouse Classroom is the first single story building on the right. The entrance faces the flag poles. For fly in aircraft, parking is on ramp in front of the FBO. The gate code is found in the FBO pilot lounge through the East door. You will need this to exit and enter the ramp.
