# IMC Club Meeting: Mastering the Art of Instrument Navigation

This month's scenario will test your tolerance for risk when flying near areas of forecasted icing conditions. You are "on top" cruising along in the clear, but below you is a widespread cloud layer containing areas of forecasted icing. As you continue along your intended route, the weather conditions you encounter are not consistent with the forecast and the situation deteriorates to the point where you need to make a critical decision now. Test your decision making skills in this critical area of IFR flying.
