Civil Air Patrol - New York City and Long Island Group Safety Down Day 2016

CAP Safety Down Day: Civil Air Patrol (CAP) MEMBERS ONLY - ID Required. This course is only open to CAP Pilots, Observers and Scanners. Course will cover: KFRG and KISP arrival, departure and operating procedures; FAA Wings program; CAP Form 5 procedures; NY Wing emphasis areas (Tires and Winter Weather); and other topics of importance to Civil Air Patrol aircrews flying out of Long Island. This Course will be repeated on January 17, 2015 @ Long Island Group Headquarters. CAP'S Mission Statement : "Supporting America's communities with emergency response, diverse aviation and ground services, youth development, and promotion of air, space and cyber power."

Directions: Take the main airport entrance (Van Wyck Expressway) southbound into the airport. Shortly after entering the airport and just past the "Welcome to JFK Airport" sign, take exit B. Immediately after exiting, go straight proceeding through the flashing yellow light onto "South Service Road." Continue very briefly on "South Service Road" and enter either of the 2 parking lot entrances on the right. (Both are for the Building #14 Parking Lot.) Check in at the Security Desk then take the elevator behind the desk to the second floor. Exit the elevator to the right and go to the very end of the hallway to the conference room on the right.
