In conjunction with airport management, we will be conducting a local RSAT meeting on Tuesday, August 13, 2019, at 10:00 a.m.

The purpose of this RSAT meeting is to unite those individuals and organizations that are actively involved in airside operations and movement of aircraft, vehicles and equipment on the Airport Operations Area (AOA). Participants are asked to help develop recommendations and solutions to enhance surface safety. Those recommendations serve as the foundation for a site-specific Runway Safety Action Plan.
