

NAFI 2026 - Safety Management System - An Effective Safety Path Forward

SMS, or Safety Management System, is the most effective safety framework to be introduced in many years. It is based on solid research, was tested initially in Canada, and is now established by EASA and the FAA as the accepted standard on which airlines, airports, and manufacturers are measured for their in-house safety structure. SMS has four pillars: 1) Safety Policy and Objectives, 2) Risk Management, 3) Safety Assurance, and 4) Safety Promotion. Each pillar requires planning and work, but when established together, they will very effectively work within an organization and generate a positive safety culture.
