This seminar will highlight the changes to the current practical test standards by updating them to the new airman certification standards. In addition the changes to the student pilot certificates and application will be gone over since they go into effect 1 April 2016. Another issue to be covered will explain the changes that are being adopted in filing an ICAO flight plan in place of the current domestic flight plan now in use in the USA.
