This Program will cover all current Regulatory, FAA Policy, and Laws related to Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems in the United States, as well as the online course and testing requirements, and the IACRA application process for Remote Pilot Certificates. As Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems will affect everyone in the aviation industry, this program is a must for all aviation operators and organizations in the United States, including those individuals, operators or operations looking to actively fly Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems in the National Air Space.
