Turn Right onto Reads Way (0.05 miles)

From I-95 North:

Take Exit 5A SR-141 S/New Castle

Keep Right at the fork to go on to Airport Road (0.7 miles) Turn Left on to Commons Boulevard/ SR-37 S (0.5 miles) Turn left on to Reads Way (0.06 miles)
