## Event Details

To promote safe flying in the McGuire Alert Area (A-220), the 305<sup>th</sup> Air Mobility Wing Flight Safety Team sponsors this program, which will cover the following topics plus a tour over 4 hours:

- 1) inform general aviation pilots about the hazards of flying in busy military airspace; and
- 2) Provide strategies for flying safely in the McGuire airspace.
