**Directions:** If you live north of Fredericksburg, take I-95 South to exit 130A (East) which is SR 3 and proceed east to about 4 mi to SR 2 and 17. Turn right (South) on 2.17 exit, which is Tidewater Trail.

If you live south of Fredericksburg, take I-95 North to exit 130A (East) which is SR 3 and proceed east for about 4 mi to SR 2 and 17. Turn right on the 2/17 exit, which is Tidewater Trail.

Shannon Airport is located about 1 mile south of SR 3 on SR 2/17 (Tidewater Trail). The airport entrance is on the right (west side) of Tidewater Trail immediately after the Wawa and across the street from the John Deere dealership. Enter on Shannon Airport Circle and park anywhere in the parking lot. The Robins Nest Cafe sign is clearly visible from the parking lot. Enter through the door to the left of the sign.
