The first part will be a review of spatial orientation and the sensations associated with normal flight maneuvers. Pilots will be provided a flight profile to be used with an instructor or safety pilot so that the sensations can be experienced safely. The second part is a discussion of common pilot mistakes and strategies to prevent the errors from occurring. The third part will be a presentation by Jen Hotsko regarding volunteer flying for instrument-rated pilots. Lastly, there will be a discussion of a real world IFR scenario.
