We will be discussing the airspace around Wallops Flight Facility and the number one cause of accidents, Loss of Control. The end goal being to better equip the communities of users with the knowledge, understanding, and methods that will allow them to safely navigate the Restricted Airspace around Wallops Flight Facility. Loss of Control In-Flight was the dominant cause of fatal general aviation accidents over the last decade. Loss of Control refers to accidents resulting from situations in which the pilot should have either maintained or regained control of the aircraft, but did not.
