On November 26, 2011, a Cirrus SR-20 plunged to the ground in suburban Chicago, killing all four occupants! What went wrong? Don't miss this exclusive interactive seminar that examines the accident that occurred when a VFR pilot in a Cirrus proceeding into Instrument Meteorological Conditions (IMC) and ultimately crashed. Featured speaker David St. George, a FAA Safety Team Lead Representative and Designated Pilot Examiner will lead this interactive discussion into what went wrong.

Directions: Follow State Route 13 North from the City of Ithaca under 2 overpasses to the top of the hill. The next light is Warren Road, turn left then your first right (about .5 mile) is Brown Road (airport entrance). Go straight to the red brick building with the airport beacon on the roof (this is the airport administration building).
