SUBJECT: RUNWAY SAFETY SEMINAR AND AIRPORT TOUR ON JUNE 8, 2013

Runway Safety is a top priority with the FAA and the Rochester Airport Traffic Control Tower, (ROC ATCT). In partnership with the Greater Rochester International Airport (KROC) and the FAA Rochester Flight Standards District Office, (FSDO-23), ROC ATCT hosts a local Runway Safety Action Team (RSAT). This group of volunteer participants, comprised of stakeholders at KROC, meets annually to develop an action plan aimed at improving runway safety at KROC.

One of the "Best Practices" created by this group is the annual opportunity for aviators to learn more about runway safety, and experience a tour of the operations areas at KROC. This guided bus tour brings you onto the runways and taxiways to learn more about signage, markings, and other airport enhancements provided to keep you and your passengers as safe as possible.

Prior to the airport tour, Air Traffic Controllers from ROC & BUF ATCTs, will provide a *virtual* tour of the Control Tower during a 1 hour safety seminar. This is a great opportunity to talk with controllers and get answers to your questions.

Also, throughout the day there will be other safety seminars, new airplanes on display, and more to see.
