Our general aviation fatal accident rate has actually increased in personal flying as other areas of aviation have achieved remarkable improvements. Featured guest speaker David St. George believes this is a result of a faulty flight training doctrine and our inability to manage risks in flying. The good news is many personal improvements can be achieved without burning avgas...just change your habits and the way you think! The new FAA Airman Certification Standards will incorporate scenario-based testing with a focus on risk management. This change is designed to encourage risk management training in the flight training environment and prepare pilots to identify and mitigate risks (ultimately reduce accidents and save lives).
