# Hangar Flying Safety Meeting

The lack of adequate and proper transition training from a qualified authorized instructor or pilot has been cited as a causal factor in many general aviation accidents. Pilots think of transition training as only necessary when stepping up to a high performance, turbine or complex airplane, or from single-engine to multi-engine, or from tricycle gear to tail wheel or from land to sea operations. However, transition training is most beneficial to pilots who are moving from certificated aircraft to amateur built or light sport flying machines, training in a Technical Advanced Aircraft (TAA), aircraft equipped with diesel engines or any other special equipment or accessories that may be installed.
