Monthly HANGAR FLYING Safety Meeting

Nearly one-third (32.9 percent) of all fatal accidents in the last 10 years occurred during maneuvering flight; which includes buzzing, formation flying, aerial work, stalls/spins, canyon flying, aerobatics, and normal flight operations. Basically, any type of flying performed close to the ground; for example, the traffic pattern or flying that involves steep turns and aerobatics is also considered maneuvering. At this important briefing, we will share mitigation strategies and best practices for minimizing your risk during maneuvering flight.
