Directions: Follow State Route 13 North from the City of Ithaca under 2 overpasses to the top of the hill. The next light is Warren Road, turn left then your first right (about .5 mile) is Brown Road (airport entrance). This is a divided highway entrance. DO NOT turn to the airlines...go straight. When the road joins back into two lanes East Hill Flying Club is on your left. Part BEYOND the hangar in the large lot.
