# **Flight Instructor Refresher Course at HELI-EXPO 2013**

This helicopter-only, two-day course covers the latest updates in regulations and helicopter flight-instruction techniques. The course consists of 16 hours of instruction, with an exam at the conclusion of each day. The curriculum and course content have been designated by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as meeting the requirements of AC 61-83G, Nationally Scheduled FAA-Approved Industry-Conducted Flight Instructor Refresher Course.

flight instructors who wish to maintain their qualifications as chief instructors or assistant chief instructors for pilot schools certificated under 14 CFR Part 141. In addition, pilots preparing for their initial rotorcraft flight instructor certificate will find this course helpful, as well as instructors preparing for an additional CFI rating.

At the conclusion of the course, HAI will issue a graduation certificate to each successful attendee. This certificate may be used as a basis for renewal of the flight instructor certificate, provided such application is made before an attendee's current instructor certificate expires and within a period of three calendar months from the date of course completion. HAI will have an airman certificate representative on-site to process certificate renewals, using the Integrated Airman Certification and/or Rating Application. In addition, the graduation certificate is valid for the one-hour ground school required for the flight review (but not the flight). It is not valid for reinstatement of a flight instructor certificate. FAA WINGS program credit is also given to successful attendees.
