**Breaking the Accident Chain - FAA Case Scenario Course at  
HELI-EXPO 2013**

This interactive course will define Controlled Flight Into Terrain (CFIT) with the latest statistics and challenges in regards to wire strikes, obstacles and terrain avoidance. Participants will be guided through a real-world FAA CFIT case using the latest Helicopter Terrain Awareness and Warning System (HTAWS) technology through a demo. All attendees will be given a demo CD to reenact their own known CFIT test scenarios with the HeliTAWS technology.

Registration is not required for this course. HOWEVER, if you wish to receive FAA WINGS Program credit you MUST register in advance of the course on the [FAASafety.gov](http://FAASafety.gov) web site.
