

# Inspection Authorization Refresher Courses at HELI-EXPO 2013

HAI offers a variety of sessions that are accepted by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for inspection authorization renewal credit. Attendees can earn IA renewal credit by choosing a least 8 hours from a total of 32 one hour technical briefings offered by rotorcraft airframe and engine manufacturers including AgustaWestland, Bell Helicopter, Enstrom, Eurocopter, Honeywell, Kaman, Lycoming Piston Engines, MD Helicopters, Pratt & Whitney, Robinson Helicopters, Rolls-Royce, Scott's Bell 47, Sikorsky, and Turbomeca. To use the briefings for IA Renewal, you must attend a minimum of eight, one-hour briefings.
