# IFR Topics For Instructors

General Aviation instrument pilots at all levels of experience often demonstrate a lack of proficiency in weather analysis, system failures, Global Positioning System (GPS) procedures, the difference between a Visual Descent Point (VDP) and a Missed Approach Point (MAP), and route planning and negotiation. Through an instructional analysis of these five topics, we will discuss scenarios the instructor can use to facilitate recognition of deficient knowledge, followed by some ideas of how to improve student learning accomplishments through the correlation level.
