This intensive course will provide new or current managers of civil helicopter operations with the management skills they need for success in today's highly demanding and complex operating environment. All types of helicopter operations, including commercial, in-house corporate, public service, and government, will be addressed.

This course is built around the development of a business case for a typical helicopter operator and will be presented in two parts. The first part will focus on the business, management, finance, and marketing concepts important for helicopter operations and will provide attendees with techniques for applying these concepts in areas such as business planning, safety management, directing and controlling, financial statement analysis, budgeting, cost analysis, defining the market and developing marketing goals, and advertising and selling your service. Class discussion and a case study of a business plan will be used throughout the course to reinforce these concepts.

In the second part of the course, attendees will develop and present case studies based on their own organizations. For the presentation, each attendee will demonstrate their knowledge of

concepts and techniques introduced during the course. Emphasis will be placed on utilizing accounting concepts; analyzing cash flow; using ratios to compare revenues, costs, and expenses between periods; and using spreadsheet programs to analyze financial data.
