IFR flight requires a pilot to organize many pieces of information into a coherent plan of action. ForeFlight provides many useful tools to facilitate this process. In this hands-on seminar, you will learn how to use ForeFlight to plan an IFR flight, select an appropriate route, obtain a weather briefing, file a flight plan, create departure and arrival alternate routes, and create approach chart binders.
