

## IFR Departure Procedures With ForeFlight

Departure from an airport in IFR conditions can be quite hazardous if proper procedures are not followed. A review of various departure procedures (ODP, SID, DDP, ATC) and relevant Advisory Circulars and AIM recommendations will kick off this seminar, followed by a hands-on demonstration of how to use ForeFlight to: assess your aircraft's performance capabilities, locate appropriate departure frequencies, construct a non-RNAV departure procedure flight plan, facilitate the proper execution of a departure procedure, use chart overlays, use weather overlays.
