The Hazardous Attitudes Lurking within You at HAI HELI-EXPO 2015

Attendees will review the five hazardous attitudes identified by the FAA as negatively affecting pilot decision making: antiauthority, impulsivity, invulnerability, macho, and resignation. We'll look at not only the rote definitions but also their practical application and manifestation in our daily operations. We will evaluate incident reports and real-life stories to find hazardous attitudes, which will be dissected to show that hazardous attitudes exist in us all and are trying hard to get out. The session will wrap up with a discussion on how to recognize and prevent these attitudes and the accidents they cause.

Attendees will: Review hazardous attitudes as described in FAA publications. Discuss the real-world application of hazardous attitudes, including the fact that everyone has them at some point during their careers and lives. Be able to recognize when a hazardous attitude is coming on or has occurred. Be able to strategize on how to prevent the accidents caused by hazardous attitudes.
