# Hope Is Not a Strategy Session at HAI HELI-EXPO 2015

An examination of how humans (pilots) make decisions and the process by which we evaluate our decisions to determine the “goodness” of the decision. We will discuss: brain function and cognition; how the “frame” in which we receive information impacts our use of the information; rational versus irrational decision-making processes (emotional brain versus rational brain); and problem analysis versus decision making.
