# Developing Rotorcraft ASI:HFDM and Research at HAI HELI- EXPO 2015

Safety improvements in rotorcraft operations are greatly desired by the FAA; it is expected that flight data monitoring (FDM) and associated products and services can contribute significantly, subject to their widespread adoption and ongoing improvements made possible by engagement with the rotorcraft safety community and the availability of FDM data. A centralized database of de-identified rotorcraft FDM data for safety analysis by the FAA and other stakeholders would be of immense value. This session is offered at the HAI Rotor Safety Challenge at HELI-EXPO 2015. Rotor Safety Challenge sessions are FREE to all HELI-EXPO 2015 attendees and exhibitors. Attend at least six Rotor Safety Challenge sessions and receive a certificate of recognition. Take the Safety Challenge in three simple steps: 1.
