Concerned about ground operations at your home base or other busy airports that you fly to? Improving surface safety at airports is a continuous process that requires the input of all airport user groups. This is your opportunity to share your concerns and suggestions. Attend this important meeting conducted by the FAA Eastern Region Runway Safety Team. The FAA has made the reduction of runway incursions and surface incidents one of its top priorities. As part of this effort, the Eastern Region Runway Safety Team will provide updated details on airport and runway markings as well as an interactive computer animation titled "Turning Point" in an ongoing effort to prevent runway incursions.

Directions: From the East, take Route 267 to Leesburg. Exit at Battlefield Parkway, continue to the traffic signal. Turn left onto Battlefield Parkway. At the next traffic signal, turn right onto Sycolin Road. Airport 1/2 mile on right.
